About

The KJEC Institute is a 12-day intensive educational program located in Honolulu, Hawai'i that brings together university students from Korea and Japan to strengthen their English language abilities, develop their leadership skills, and expand their cross-cultural understanding. Utilizing experiential and project-based learning, the Institute aims to teach the value of international collaboration and encourage the reciprocal exchange of diverse ideas and perspectives in an immersive English environment. The program is organized and operated by Korea-Japan English Camp Inc. (KJEC), a nonprofit organization with a mission to provide students access to international and experiential education with the goal of fostering future global leaders and changemakers. The program is funded through the support of a grant from the Public Diplomacy Section, U.S. Embassy Seoul.

Program Goals

It is our aim that participating students will:

- Expand their awareness and understanding of social justice issues from a local and global perspective.
- Develop their leadership and professional skills and efficacy to create community change.
- Improve their English language competencies as a tool for global communication.
- Increase their knowledge of Korean, Japanese, American, and native Hawaiian cultures and the value of international collaboration.
- Increase their knowledge of higher education opportunities, resources, and student life in the US.
- Build a network for future communication and collaboration.

Program Benefits

The Institute covers program tuition, round-trip airfare, meals, accommodations, and excursion costs for all program participants thanks to the support of a grant from the U.S. Embassy in Seoul.

Participant Eligibility

The Institute aims to bring students together from different schools, backgrounds, and academic disciplines. To apply, students must meet the following requirements:

- Must be enrolled in a university for the 2021 fall semester

- Able to complete a written application, short essay questions, and an oral interview in English
- Have an interest in English as a global language
- Have an interest in cross-cultural learning and communication, social justice, leadership for positive change, and personal and professional development

Application Process

The Institute has a two-step application process. During the first round, students must complete and submit an electronic application and short video recording. Semi-finalists will be selected from this group and asked to complete an online interview. Finalists and alternates will be selected from this group and notified on April 5, 2021. Selected students must agree to attend the full-duration of the program and actively participate in classroom and community activities. Finalists are required to attend two pre-departure orientation sessions on April 11th and May 30th, 2021.

Applicants should be able to articulate why they are interested in this program and how this program will help them achieve their personal and professional goals.

Evaluation and Selection

The KJEC Institute will select 20 university students to participate in the Institute (10 students from Korean universities and 10 students from Japanese universities). All eligible students are encouraged to apply.

Special consideration will be given to students who meet the following criteria:

- Students with no (or limited) international travel experience

- Students who have experienced financial stress or hardship or other life adversities
- Students attending a university located outside the Seoul/Tokyo metropolitan area
- Students with a hometown residence outside the Tokyo/Seoul metropolitan area
- Students with the ability to actively and productively engage in conversations on various social topics in an immersive English environment

The KJEC Institute will select students based on a holistic evaluation, giving consideration to English skills, leadership qualities, cultural awareness, and overall character. The Institute is not focused on selecting a university's top student, nor is the selection based solely on one's academic performance. Our program will select participants who demonstrate the qualities of a cultural ambassador and have clearly articulated how this program will benefit their future academic plans and or professional careers and local communities.

Student applicants should have a passion for English, an interest in becoming local and global leaders, and a willingness to step outside of their comfort zones. Selected students should be prepared to participate in an English immersion environment that consists of a combination of classroom learning and community engagement activities, including cultural excursions, community service, and guest speakers, group projects, discussions, and presentations.

- Selected participants will attend the KJEC Institute for FREE thanks to the financial support of the U.S. Embassy in Seoul. The Institute will cover students' tuition, round-trip airfare, program transportation, meals, and accommodations during the program dates. Students will be responsible for the costs of any extracurricular activities not designated on the itinerary as well as any souvenirs or other personal items a student may want or need.
- Participants will be expected to acquire a valid passport at their own expense if they do not already have one. They must also complete and pay for an [ESTA application](#) and processing fee. The estimated cost of the ESTA and passport application is \$14 and \$50 USD, respectively.
- Participants will be housed in a student dormitory with shared bathroom and kitchen spaces. Participants will be expected to have roommates. KJEC will distribute a rooming form to help accommodate students' rooming needs and preferences.
- KJEC will coordinate airfare and housing logistics during the program dates. Participants will be asked to coordinate ground transportation to their local airport and submit their receipts to the KJEC Directors for reimbursement. Participants may be encouraged to stay at a hotel the night before departure to ensure on-time arrival at the airport. If a participant needs to fly to a regional airport before departing for Honolulu, a KJEC Director will contact the student directly to help arrange these travel plans.
